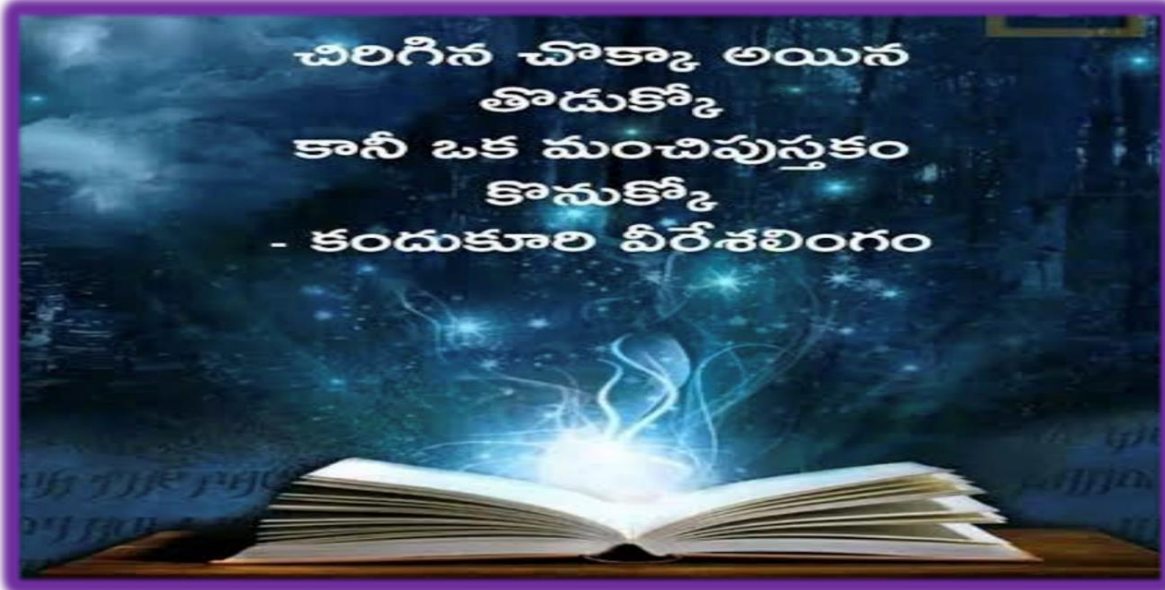

By integrating language learning with real-world awareness, this initiative not only supports academic growth but also prepares students for informed and responsible citizenship.

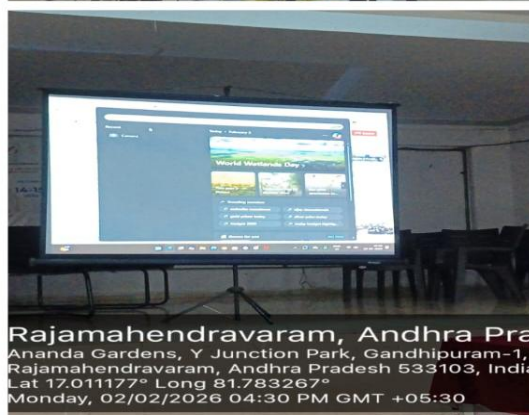


Video Conference Conducted by the Commissioner of Collegiate Education

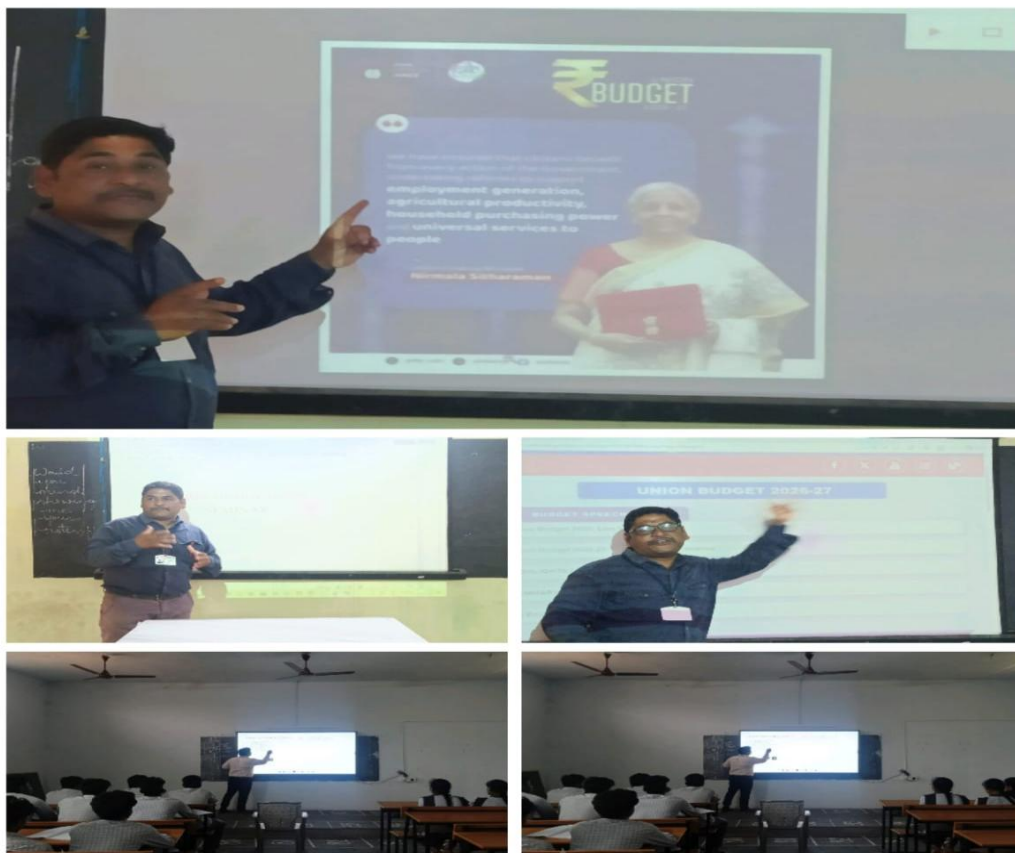
Union Budget -2026

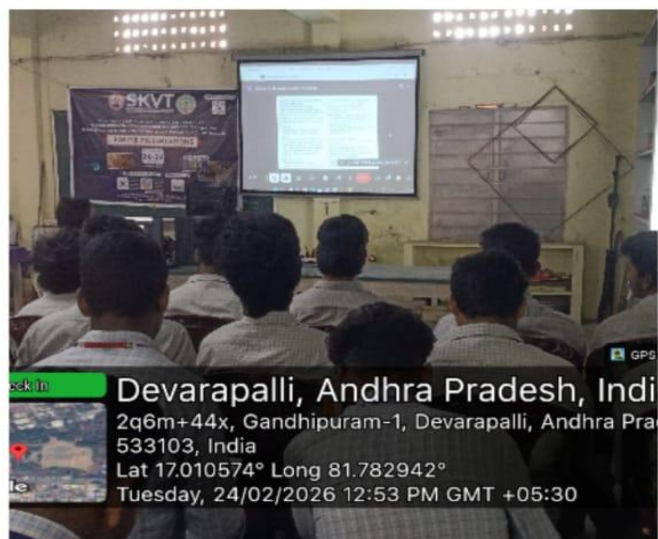

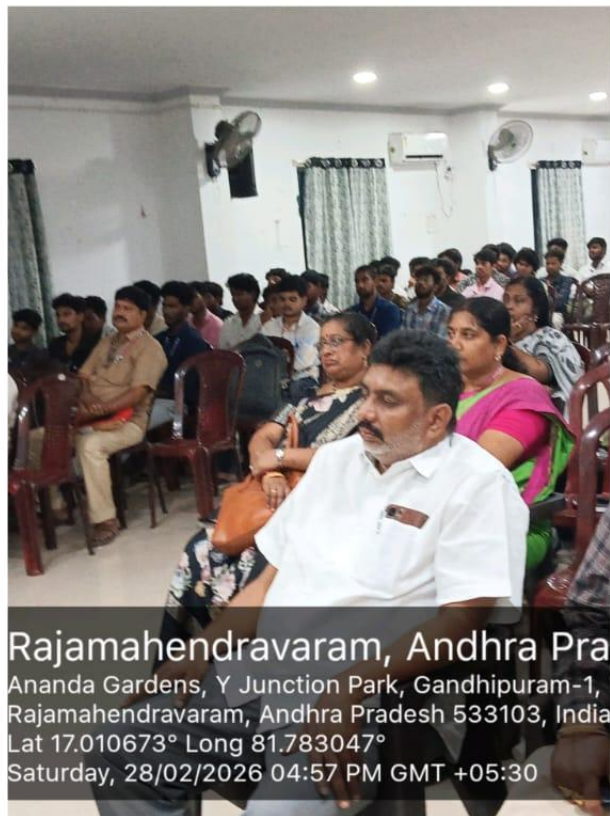
