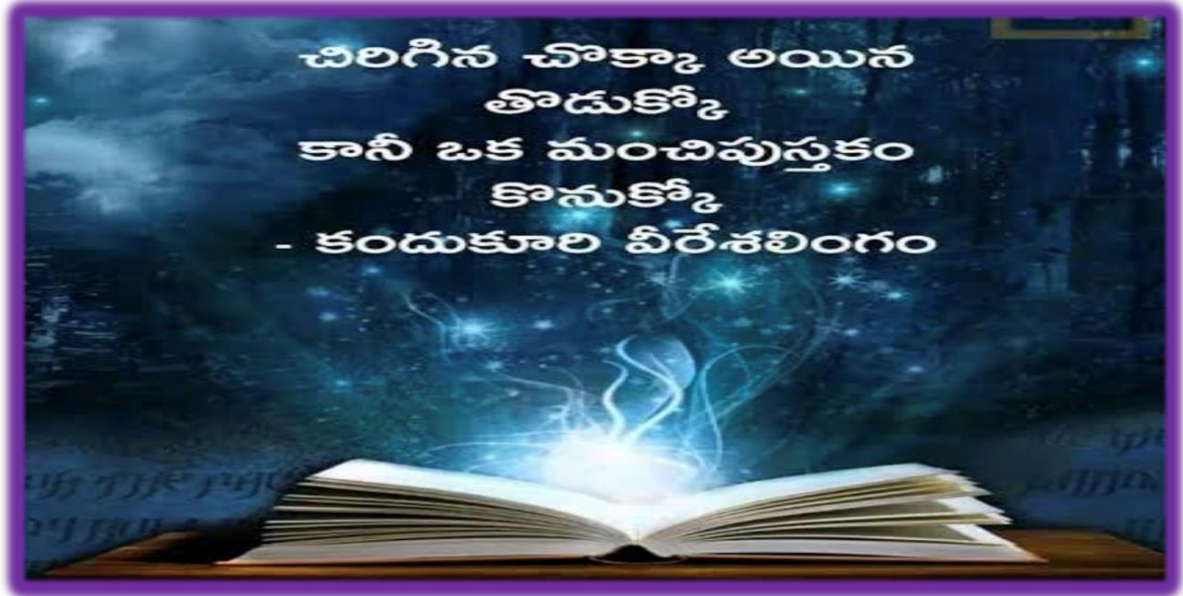

The Department of English, under the guidance of IQAC of the College, has launched two significant initiatives aimed at enhancing students' language proficiency and social awareness:

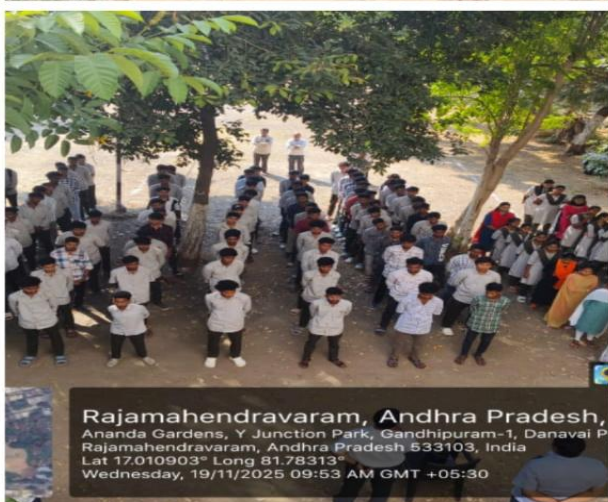
1. "Daily Spotlight" – News Bulletin via Public Address System

By integrating language learning with real-world awareness, this initiative not only supports academic growth but also prepares students for informed and responsible citizenship.

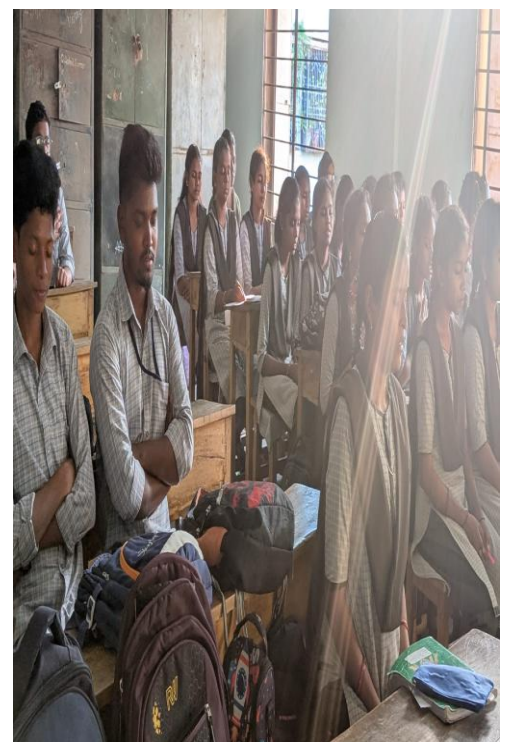


MAANASA Programme on Positive Affirmation & Confidence Building

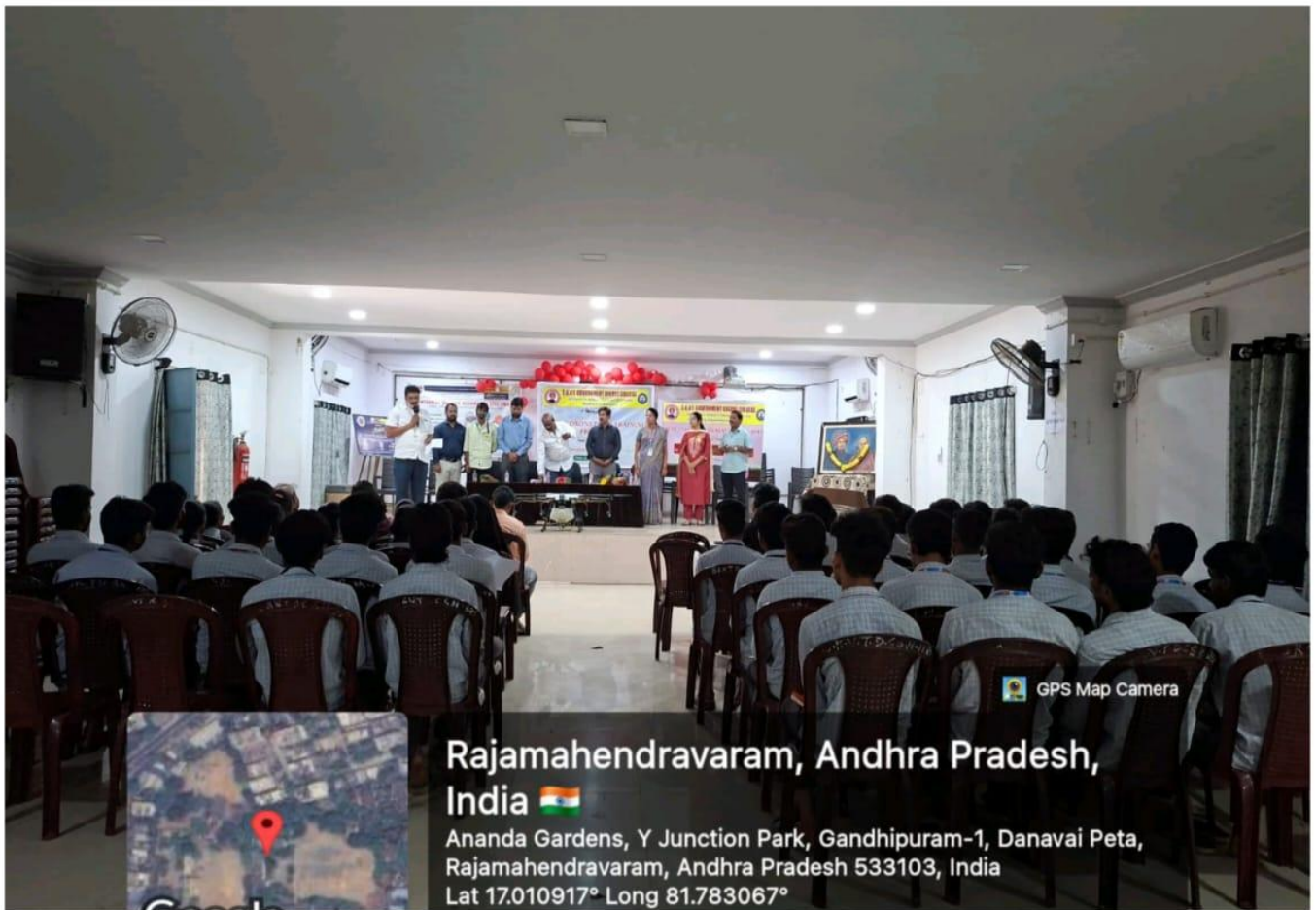
FIVE-DAYS AERIAL DRONE PILOT TRAINING PROGRAM
