



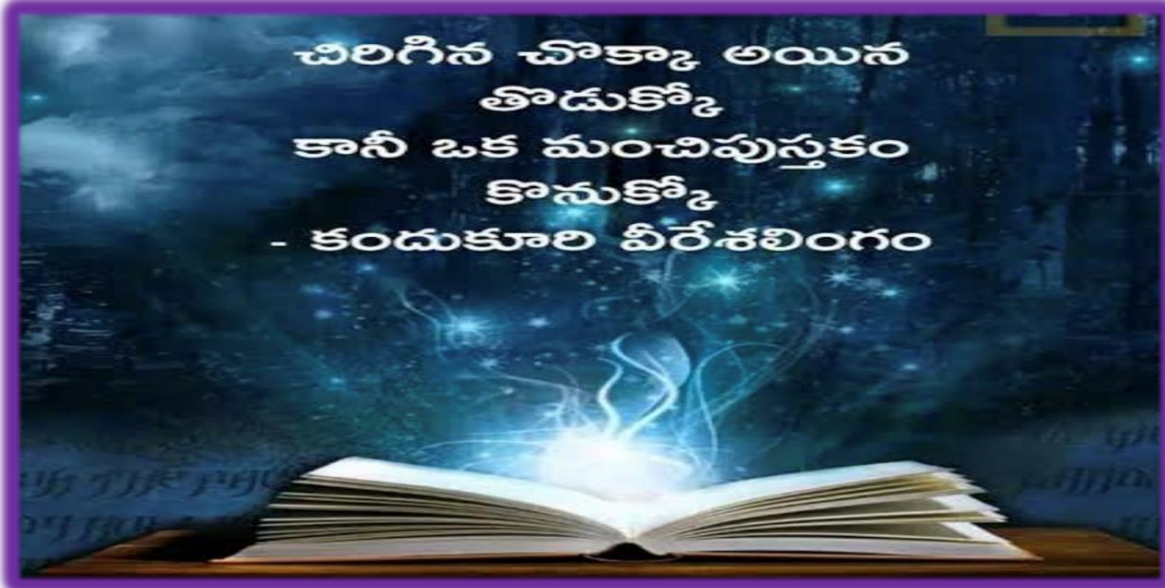

The Department of English, under the guidance of IQAC of the College, has launched two significant initiatives aimed at enhancing students' language proficiency and social awareness:

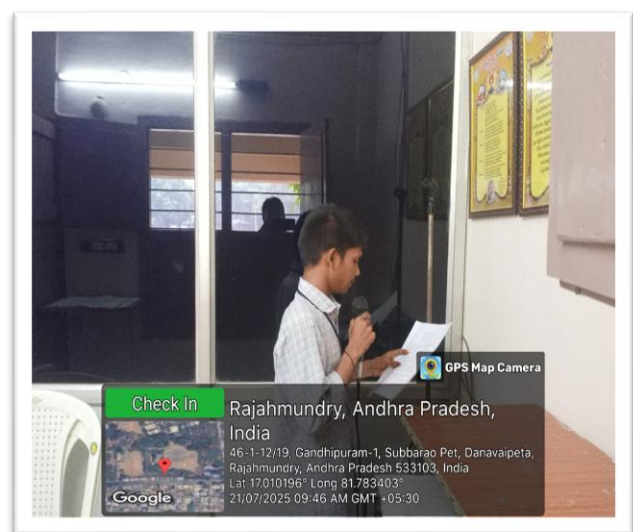
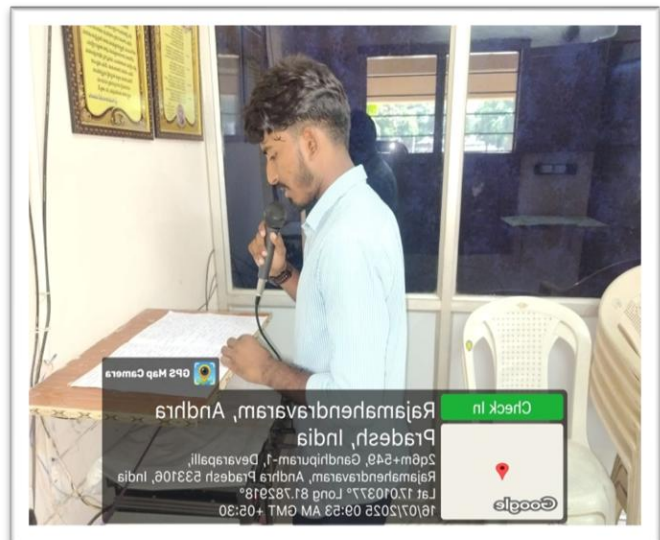
1. "Daily Spotlight" – News Bulletin via Public Address System

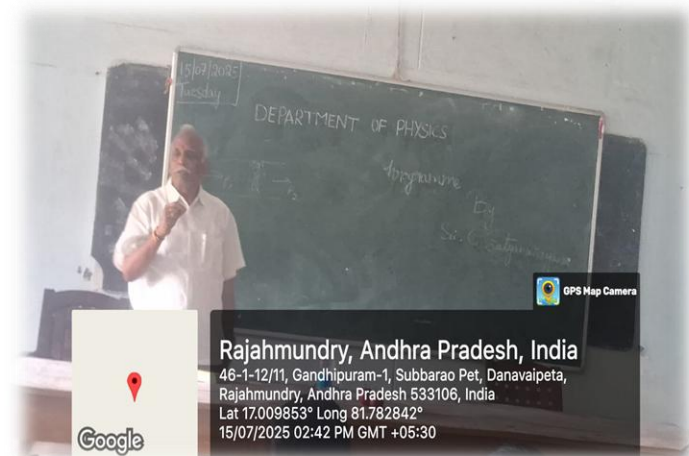


Guest Lecture: Heat and Thermodynamics

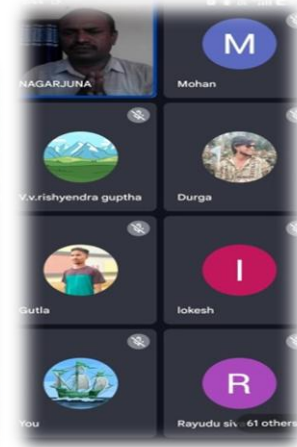
Webinar on Professional Skills for UG Students

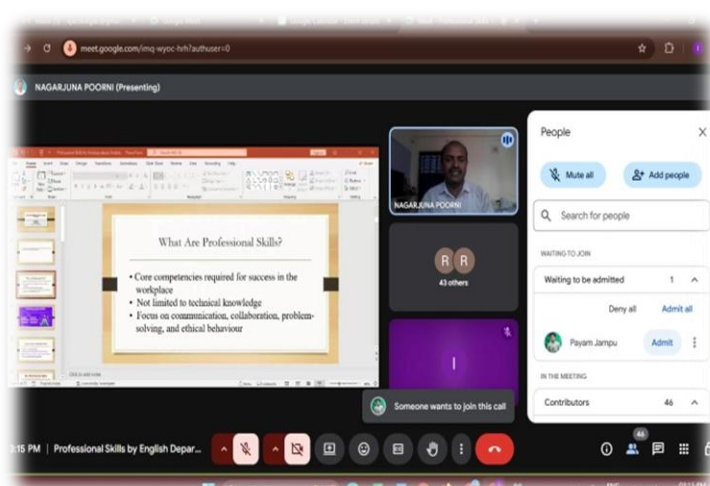

successfully ignited interest in entrepreneurship and equipped students with the basic knowledge and confidence to consider starting their own ventures in the future.



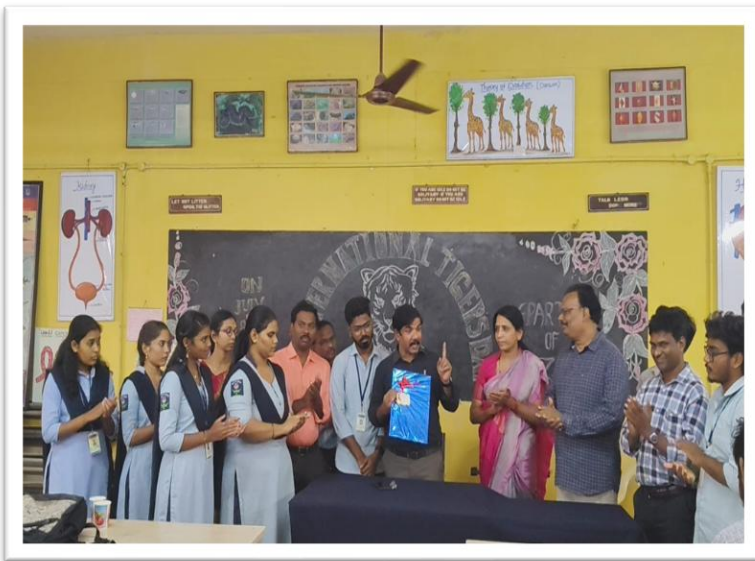
National Biodiversity Conservation Day

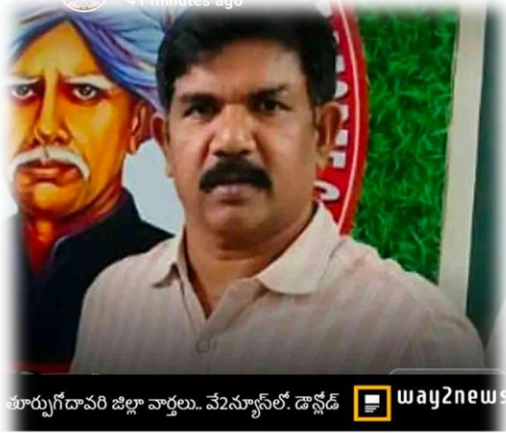
MoU with Data-Pro
