# Anti- Ragging Committee

Ragging is a reprehensible act that undermines the dignity and safety of students. Recognizing this, SKVT Government Degree College, Rajahmundry, has adopted a zero-tolerance policy towards ragging, strictly following the UGC regulations under the Act of 1956, amended as the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009.

To uphold these standards, the College has constituted a dedicated Anti-Ragging Cell, under the leadership of the Principal, with the Vice-Principal and three faculty members as coordinators. This Cell plays a crucial role in ensuring a ragging-free campus.

### Objectives:

The committee will decide and finalize Anti Ragging Regulations for the institution, in accordance with the prevailing regulations of various statutory bodies.

- ❖ Prevention: Proactively prevent incidents of ragging within the institution.
- ❖ Awareness: Conduct programs to educate students and staff about the harmful impacts of ragging.
- ❖ Support: Provide assistance and counseling to victims.
- ❖ Investigation: Promptly inquire into reported incidents.
- ❖ Disciplinary Action: Recommend strict punitive measures against offenders.
- ❖ Safe Environment: Promote a healthy, secure, and respectful campus atmosphere.
- ❖ Information Dissemination: Clearly communicate anti-ragging regulations and consequences.

### Preventive Measures & Awareness Activities:

#### 1) Before Commencement of Classes:

II & III-year students are personally counseled by tutors. NSS units under IQAC collaborate with local police to conduct awareness sessions on anti-ragging.

#### 2) At Admission:

Newly admitted I-year students participate in orientation sessions detailing how to identify and report ragging.

#### 3) Posters & Flex Boards:

Prominently displayed across the campus, showcasing definitions, punishments, and the anti-ragging helpline numbers.

#### 4) WhatsApp Communication:

Contact details of the Anti-Ragging Squad are circulated in all student WhatsApp groups for quick reporting.

#### Nature of Ragging & Penalties - Nature of Ragging    Punishment

- Teasing, embarrassing, humiliating    Imprisonment - Up to 6 months or fine up to Rs.1, 000
- Assault, criminal force, intimidation - Up to 1 year imprisonment or Rs.2, 000 fine
- Wrongful restraint, confinement, causing hurt - Up to 2 years imprisonment or Rs.5, 000 fine
- Grievous hurt, kidnapping, unnatural offences -    Up to 5 years imprisonment + Rs.10, 000 fine
- Causing death, abetting suicide - Up to 10 years imprisonment + Rs.50, 000 fine
- A convicted student will be expelled.
- Students imprisoned for more than 6 months will not be admitted elsewhere.
- Any student with prima facie evidence of ragging is immediately suspended.

#### Functions / Responsibilities of the Cell:

- Monitoring: Keep a vigilant watch on student behavior.
- Enquiry: Investigate reported incidents impartially.
- Reporting: Escalate cases to higher authorities.
- Awareness: Organize workshops, campaigns, and seminars.
- Support: Offer counseling to both victims and perpetrators.
- Policy Implementation: Enforce anti-ragging guidelines stringently.
- Collaboration: Engage parents, faculty, and staff to build a collective stand against ragging.

#### Action Taken Report (2024-25)

##### Affidavit Collection:

Anti-Ragging affidavits were collected from all newly admitted students, securing their pledge against any ragging activity.

##### Orientation:

Special sessions were conducted highlighting the college's anti-ragging stance, helpline numbers, and reporting procedures.

##### Visual Communication:

Posters and billboards outlining the consequences of ragging were displayed throughout the campus.

##### Online Presence:

Details of the Anti-Ragging Committee, along with their contact information, have been made available on the college website, student's whatsapp groups, and every corridor of for easy access.
