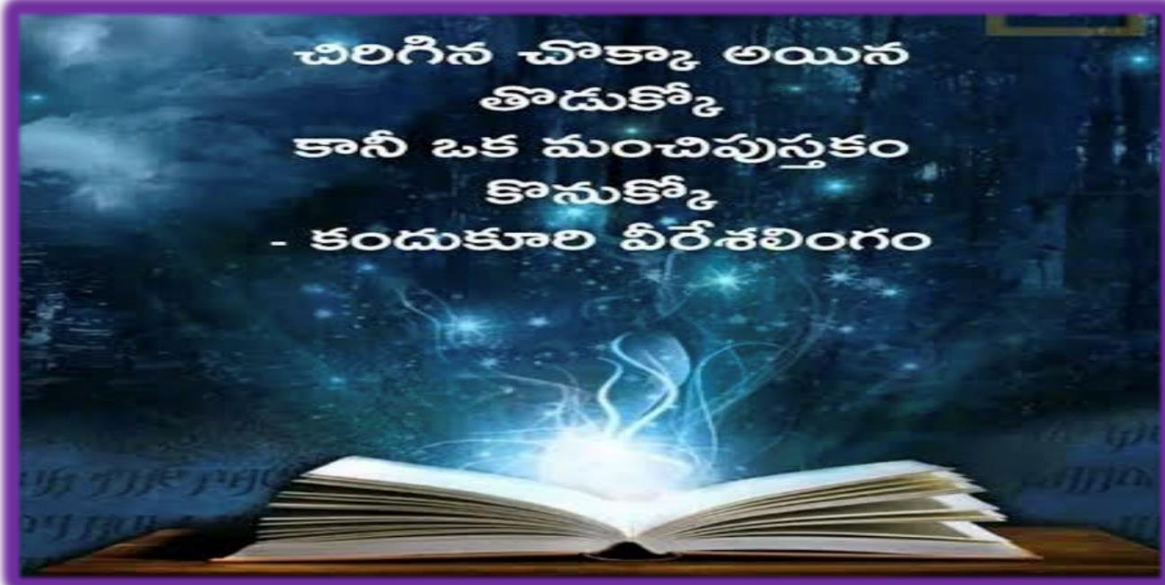

The Department of English, under the guidance of IQAC of the College, has launched two significant initiatives aimed at enhancing students' language proficiency and social awareness:

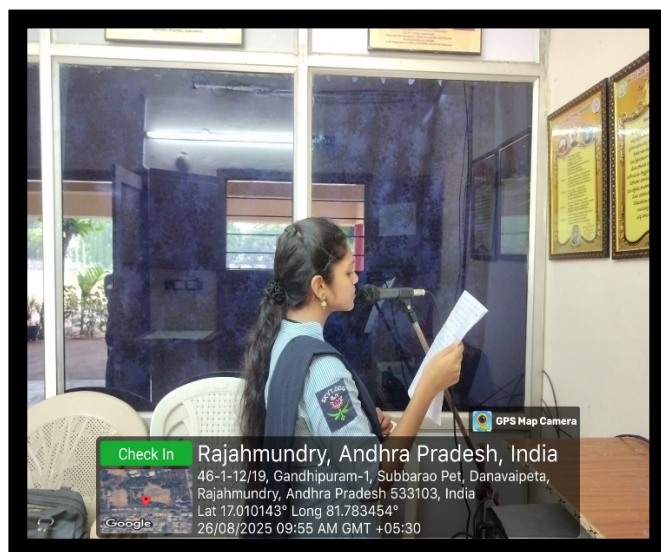
1. "Daily Spotlight" – News Bulletin via Public Address System

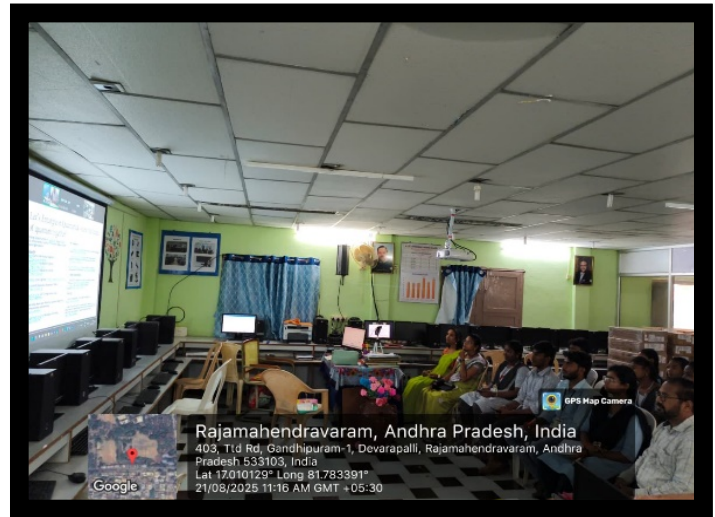
Telugu Matalaloni Varnamala Antarnirmanam Vagdevatha

Vinayak Patri Exhibition

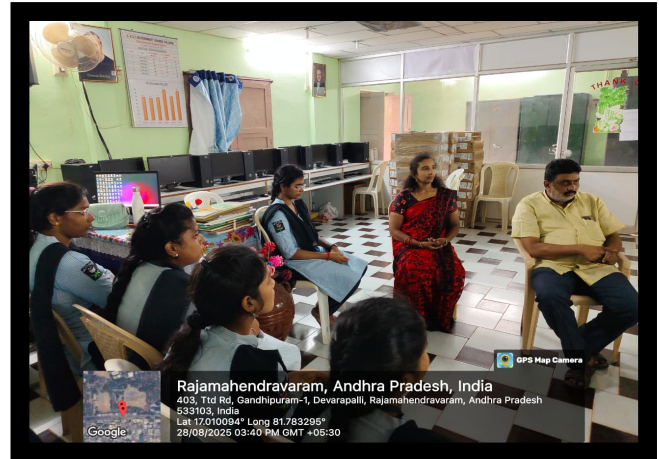

Counselling Class for Students

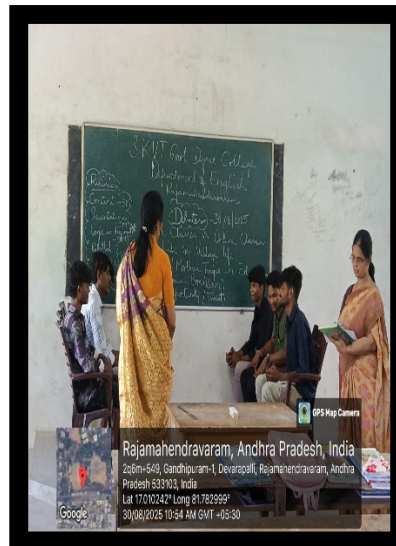

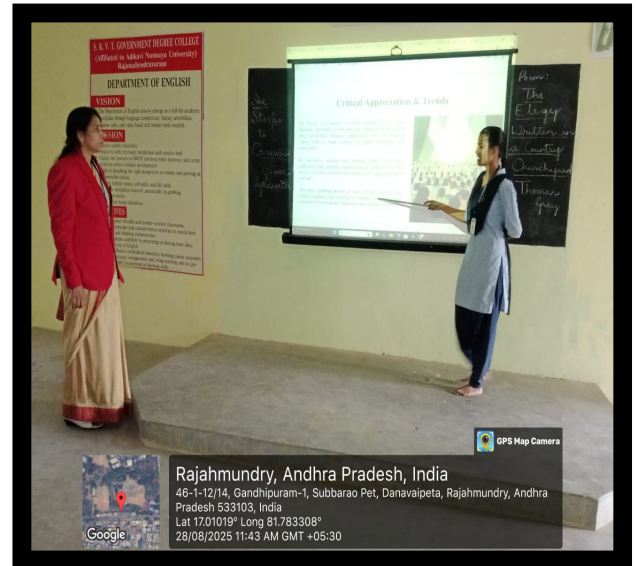
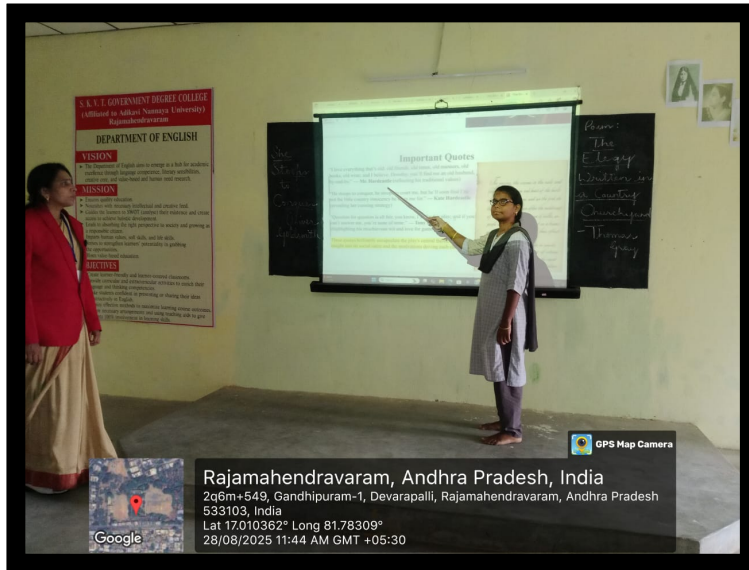
