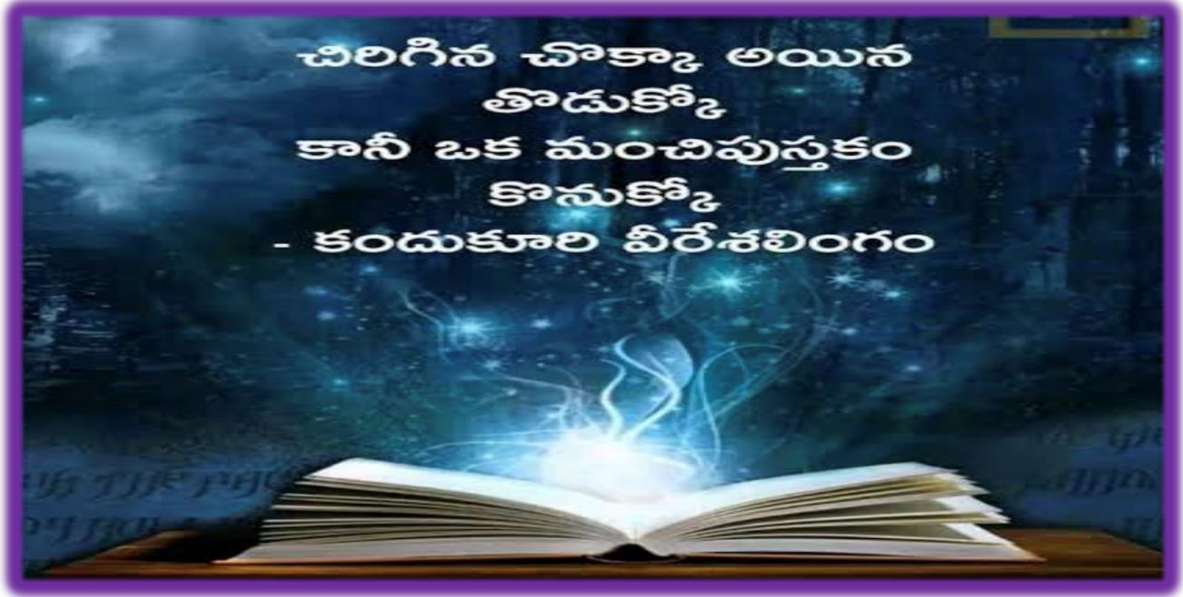

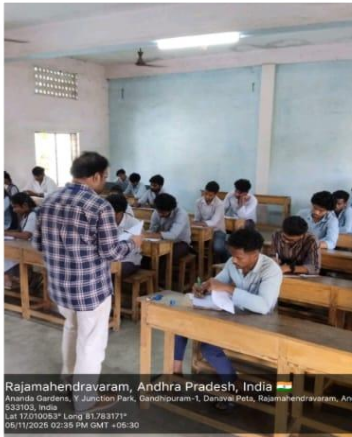
Inspection by the NCC Officers for Raising the NCC Unit at SKVT GDC

SKVT GDC continues to promote cultural and patriotic activities that inspire young minds and enrich the academic environment.

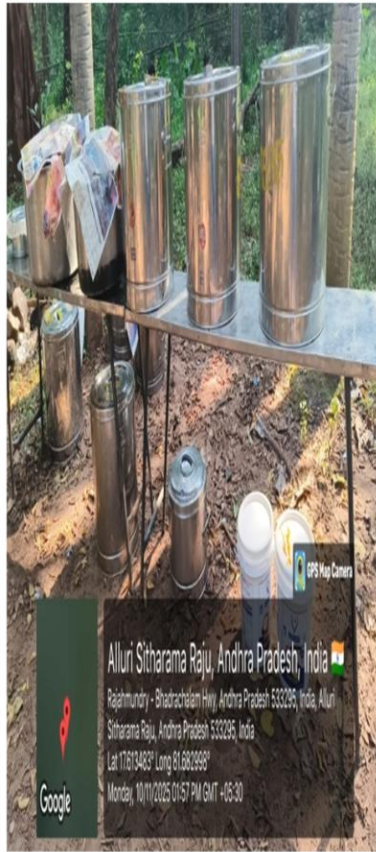
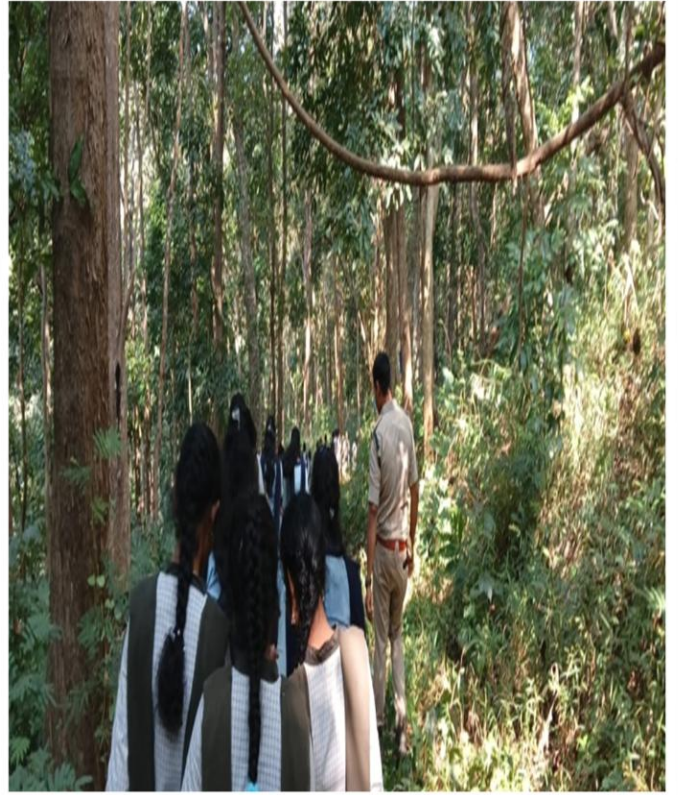


Eco Tour

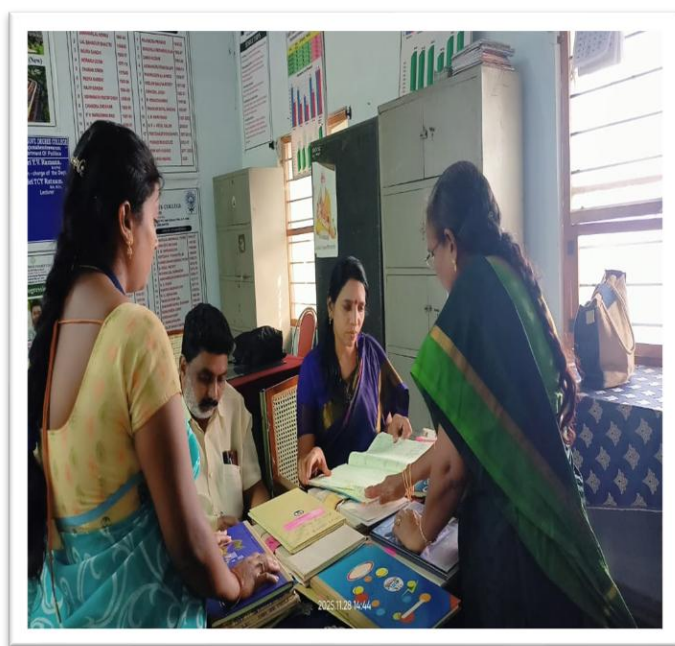
