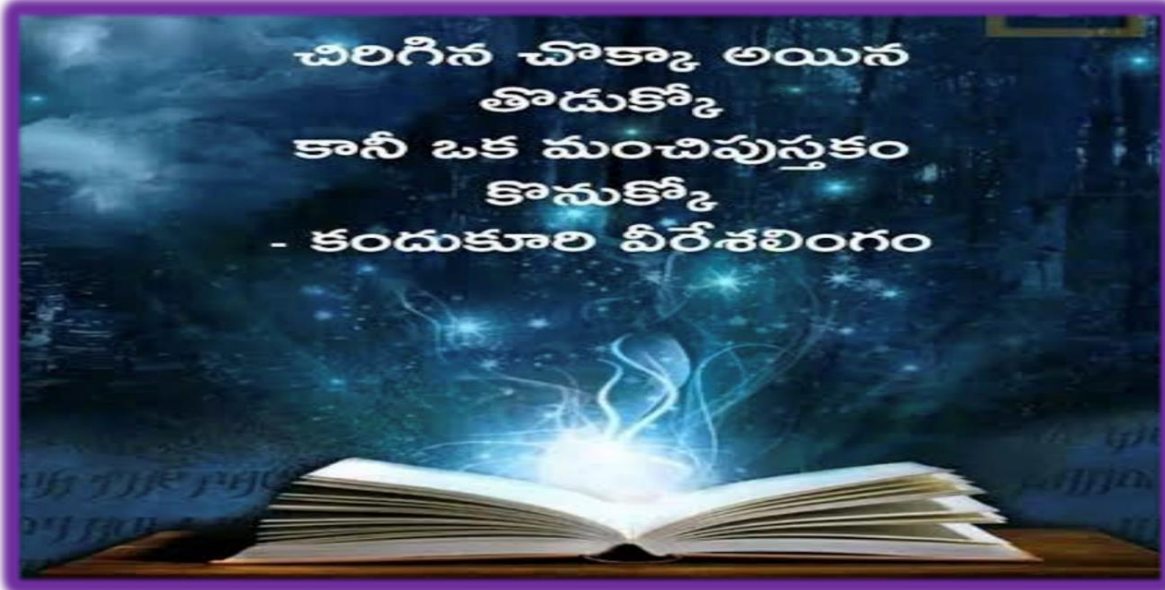

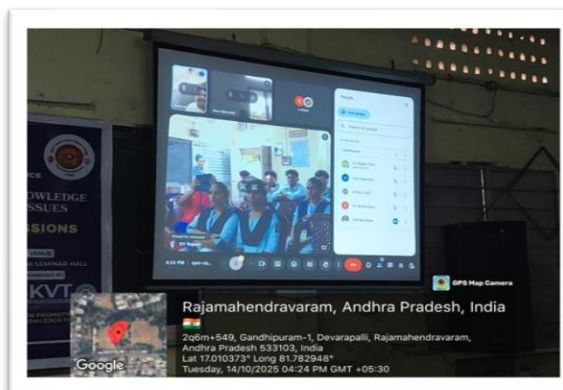
Scholars from different universities and international delegates participated enthusiastically, sharing their research and insights. Students also presented papers and posters, exhibiting great academic interest and creativity.
